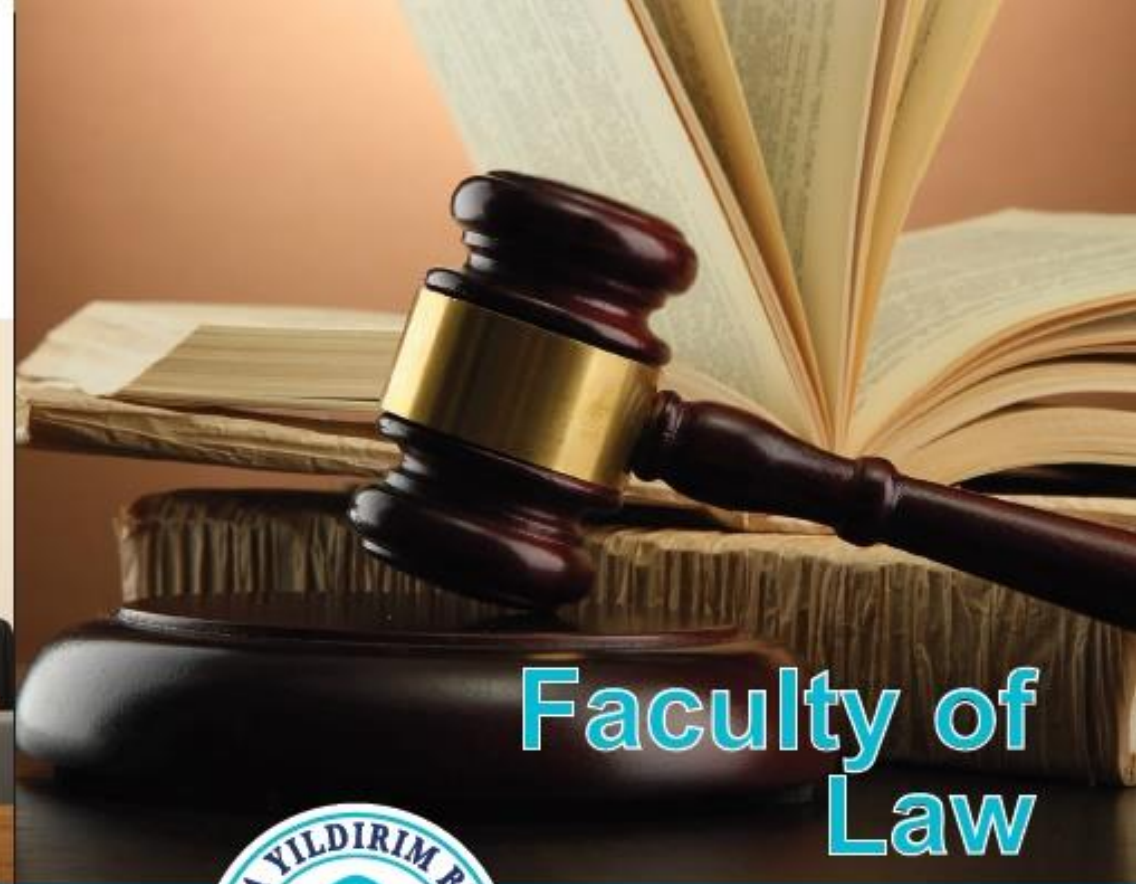


There are many reasons to prefer Ankara Yıldırım Beyazıt University Faculty of Law;
