

There are many reasons to prefer Ankara Yıldırım Beyazıt University Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences;

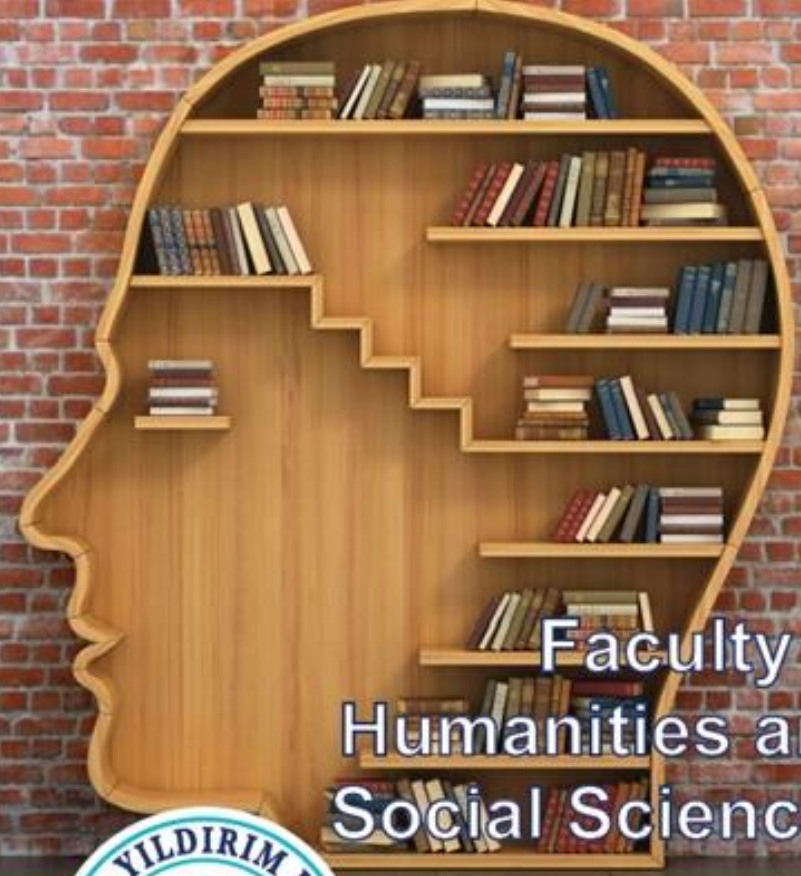
Department of Information and Documentation Management provides the necessary skills to organize access, publication and reuse of the written, pressed and electronic data.
